### Introduction

The Coordinating Committee is a standing committee of the Board of Education.

# **Policy**

## 1. Membership

- Chair of the Board of Education (Chair of the Committee)
- Vice-Chair of the Board
- Superintendent of Schools/CEO
- Secretary-Treasurer/CFO

If either the Chair or the Vice-Chair is unable to attend the Coordinating Committee meeting, they will try to arrange for an alternate Trustee to attend. If this is not possible, the Coordinating Committee meeting will proceed as scheduled.

## 2. Scope of Functions

The Coordinating Committee shall meet prior to every Board meeting to:

- prepare an agenda for the Incamera and Public Board meetings;
- refer matters requiring committee-level attention to appropriate committees;
- review and evaluate all Policies directly pertaining to the Coordinating Committee function at least once every four years.

The Decisions of the Coordinating Committee are provided to all Trustees.
